Demographics. The labor force commuting area has a population of 297,500 and a civilian labor force of 143,000. Manufacturing employment in the region is 52,939 (36.0%). Approximately 20,100 workers are identified as available to new industry.

Tishomingo County is rated "Top Ten Communities in the South for Manufacturing" by Southern Business & Development. In 2012, 2013, 2014, & 2018 four Tishomingo County industrial projects won national INNOVATION AWARDS from the National Association of Development Organizations. Southern Business & Development has also recognized Tishomingo County as one of the TOP TEN rural locations in the South for reshored industry and a top location for automotive suppliers.
