TISHOMINGO COUNTY RANKS TOP THREE IN ECONOMIC IMPROVEMENT OVER THE PAST TEN YEARS. Each year the Mississippi Department of Revenue ranks each county based on unemploy-

ment rate and per capita income compared to the other 81 counties.

In 2019, Tishomingo County was ranked # 37, an increase from # 32 in 2018, and a increase from # 14 in 2009 (higher numbers indicate lower unemployment and higher per capita income).

The data document that Tishomingo County is making substantial economic progress. In fact, the improvement in employment and per capita income for Tishomingo County over the past ten years exceeds the economic improvement of all other counties in Mississippi except two (Webster and Tippah).

With less than 20,000 citizens, a high percentage of the working age population not in the workforce, and a high percentage of retired and disabled persons, Tishomingo County faces substantial challenges, especially with lack of available labor, job skills, rental and owner housing, and home-owned businesses. More effort is required to address these issues to prevent the county from sliding backwards.

Opportunities for Independence

REHABILITATION SERVICES. Tishomingo County has one of the highest rates of disability in the state. Thousands of Mississippians with disabilities are employed each year through the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services. No-cost services to individuals include helping discover what jobs you like; determining what type of work you are good at doing; obtaining the training you need; offering specialized help that you may need to do your job; and assisting with college expenses.

MDRS works with businesses to promote diversity in the workplace; provide a job ready workforce; and to provide no-cost resources and training. Nocost services to businesses include referral of job ready candidates; technical assistance; job coaching; follow-up support; Work Opportunity Tax Credit; on-the-job training; and job site accommodations and building accessibility evaluations.

MDRS also operates 15 facilities across the state called AbilityWorks which provide employment and training to Mississippians with disabilities through sub-contacts with businesses. AbilityWorks rates are very competitive and provide flexible resources to businesses and industries.
